The parties have filed a proposal for the distribution of the residual from the Sleeper Berth Settlement, which was granted final approval by this Court on October 21, 2024. *See* ECF No. 392. Having reviewed the proposal, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Atticus Administration, LLC (“Atticus Administration”) is authorized to distribute residual funds in the following order of priority:
  - a. First, honor approximately 37 otherwise valid claims that were filed after the claim deadline. These claimants will receive the share of the Sleeper Berth Settlement that they would have received if they had filed timely. These checks will be issued no later than August 1, 2025, and have an expiration date of December 31, 2025.
  - b. Second, continue to reissue expired checks from the December 2024 distribution upon request (to the extent funds are available at time of request) through November 1, 2025. All reissued checks will have an expiration date of December 31, 2025.

c. Third, members of the Federal Wage Collective (individuals who opted in to the case during the litigation or during the original settlement of the non-sleeper berth claims) will be allowed to submit new Sleeper Berth claims through October 1, 2025 (to the extent funds are still available at time of filing), and receive the share of the Sleeper Berth Fund they would have received if they had filed timely. These checks will be issued no later than November 1, 2025, and will have an expiration date of December 31, 2025.


d. If a residual amount still remains as of January 1, 2026, this amount will be issued to Iowa Legal Aid, as a *cy pres* designee.

2. The Court approves the proposed use of no more than \$7,400 from the Sleeper Berth Dispute Fund, to compensate Atticus Administration for the cost of administering the distribution of the residual.

3. The parties should submit a final status report on January 15, 2026.
